€2.6 million for Research into Deepfakes and Infodemics

In February 2023 project SOLARIS will begin, which will investigate the political risks of fake news and deepfakes. The project was awarded a €2.6 million grant from the Horizon Europe programme and will be led by Management Team member Federica Russo. 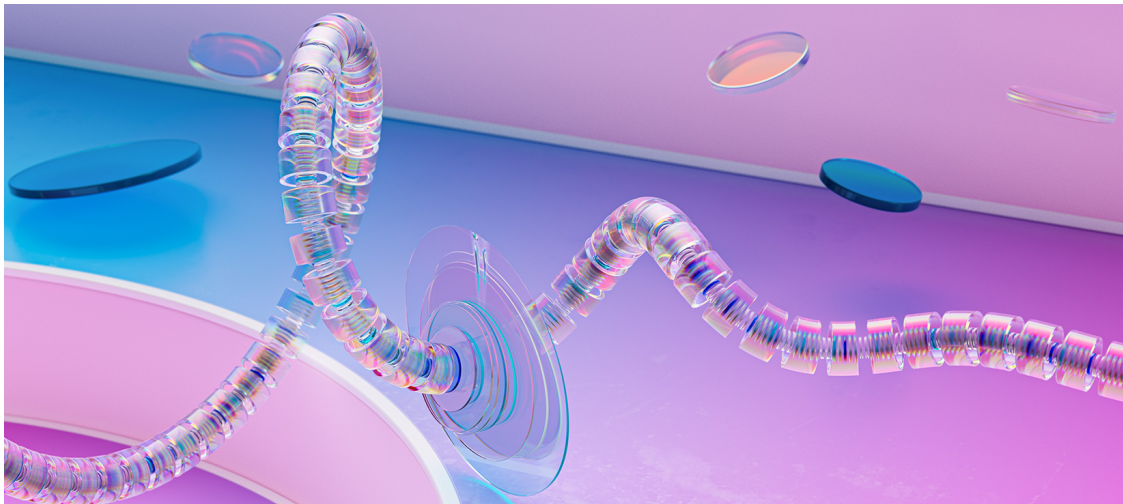


IAS Review edition 4 is out!
