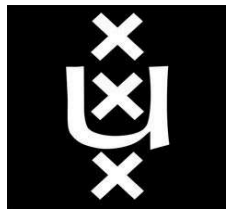

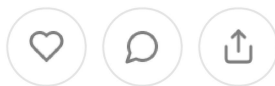

## ENLENS call for project proposals

With this call, ENLENS aims to offer initial funding for cross-faculty initiatives, creating new opportunities for researchers to apply their expertise in an interdisciplinary approach. The goal is to facilitate the development of joint proposals for securing external research funding.

 Application deadlines: 1 April and 1 October, **but intermediate submissions are also considered.**

Each faculty is eligible for funding up to **€15,000**, with an additional **€15,000** available for data acquisition/preparation if well justified, resulting in a maximum funding cap of **€45,000** per project.
